If your donations are within a reasonable distance, we may be able to pick up the items or the items can be dropped off at 2 Cain Road by appointment.**

Arts and crafts - non-toxic paints (not from Dollar Stores, not safe), brushes, easels, crayons, paper, canvases, clay, clay tools, playdough, popsicle sticks, clothes pins, markers, pencils, pens, gallons of glue, rulers, tape, colored duct tape, etc. Please, NO GLITTER (unless biodegradable)

Equipment - sewing machines, microscopes, computers, laminator, shovels, pitchforks, rakes, wheel barrel, composter, telescopes, food processor, blenders, immersion blender, cookware (Please, NO ARTIFICIAL COATINGS, LIKE TEFLON), mixing bowls, kitchen utensils/tools, cutting boards, binoculars, cameras, gaming equipment, musical instruments

Woodworking Tools - hammers, screwdrivers, hand saws, electric tools, dremel, wood burners, level, measuring tapes, drill, sand paper, pliers, wrenches, files, chisels

Sewing/Fiber Tools - sewing needles of different sizes, sewing implement, threads, knitting needles, yarn, crochet hooks, fabric scissors, tape measure, common pins, pin cushions, thimbles, tailor chalk, looms, other notions, fabric, felt

Technology - computers, tablets, microscopes, microphone, earphones/headphones, materials for building, materials for robotics

Miscellaneous - bean bag chairs, buttons, baskets, balls, sport's equipment, books, board games, dress up clothes, jewelry making supplies and tools, trowels, pruners, liquid starch, flour, baking soda, vinegar, baking soda, food coloring, cornstarch, aprons, science tools
